
- Where: Sandston Community Center, Finley Road

# Our Speaker

George Vetrovec, MD became a
Sandstonite at age 6. He attended Sandston
Elementary and Highland Springs High Schools,
then catapulted to the University of Virginia
where he got its highest undergraduate degree
(Phi Beta Kappa) and then Medical degrees;
onward to VCU's Internal Medicine and
Cardiology training. In the next decades he was
a VCU professor, directed its Cardiac
Catheterization Laboratory and chaired its
Division of Cardiology. Meanwhile he was:

- Vcu's Chief Medical Resident
- First recipient of the Kimmerling Eminent Professorship
- Spearheaded 2 charity fund-raisers that got more than \$15 million
- Established the Vcu Pauley Heart Center
- First Irby Philanthropic Leadership Award at Mcv
- Authored 350 papers, 8 book chapters and 2 texts
- $\bullet$  2 years after the world's  $1^{st}$  surgical unclogging of a heart artery George did the same at  $V_{\text{CU}}$

- President of these: Society for Cardiac Angiography & Interventions, Association of Professors of Cardiology, Association of University Cardiologists
- Awarded for consistently contributing to heart care
- Awarded for physician excellence (Master of Science)
- National Award of Merit in 1991
- First recipient of the Richmond Golden Heart Award in 1997
- Launched former trainees into 7 countries and most US states

After 39 years he retired but remains an honored Professor (Emeritus).
